Towards the vision

Leith Junction aims to provide a cultural hub for Leith, relevant at local, national and international levels. A dynamic cultural programme of theatre, dance, music and visual arts will aim to draw in national and international theatre and dance companies, music and artists to the excellent performance, rehearsal and exhibition spaces. A core programme of exciting, high quality productions will be developed, around which use of the facilities by local community groups and schools can be programmed. Leith Junction will initially be a receiving house for productions, but in time may seek to establish resident companies who will use it as a base to produce new material.

Potential users

Positive discussions are taking place with a number of organisations interested in the use of the facilities, including the Edinburgh Fringe and International Festivals, Out of the Blue, Iron-Oxide/Conflux, Leith School of Art, Leith Festival, Leith FM Radio, Stevenson College and Strangetown Youth Theatre have already noted their willingness to be regarded as key stakeholders in the development of the Options Appraisal, and other organisations will be identified through market research and further consultation prior to the completion of the Options Appraisal in December 2009.
